Personal History

William FITZPATRICK was born at Salford, Lancashire in 1896 the son of William and Catherine FITZPATRICK nee CARY who were married 1894 at Salford Register Office or Registrar Attended. His mother died in 1924.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 41, Springvale Roadm Pendleton,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Leaning Electricity Trade.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Agecroft as a Cleaner

Service History

He was living at Pendleton. Lancashire when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 24 September 1915. His last known address was Pendleton, Springvale Road, 41 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 6 July 1916 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
