***Personal History***

*John FLETCHER was born at Bolton, Lancashire in 1896 the son of John and Martha FLETCHER nee HOWARTH who were married 1892 at Bolton Register Office or Registrar Attended. His mother died in 1920. In the 1911 census the family were living at Hutton School, Near Preston,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Scholar.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 6, Dobson Street, Bolton,. He was aged 5*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Premium Apprentice*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 28 September 1918 aged 21*
