Personal History

Dennis FOGARTY was born at Ancoats, Manchester in 1894 the son of James and Lucy A. FOGARTY nee SWEENEY who were married 1893 at Manchester Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died on . In the 1911 census the family were living at 45, Barratt Street, Manchester,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Errand Boy.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 12, Glover Street, Manchester,. He was aged 7

He was a married man. His wife's name was Violet FOGARTY (nee EASTWOOD) They married at Prestwich Registry Office or Registrar Atended on 30 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Newton Heath Shops as a Labourer

Service History

He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 25 January 1915. His last known address was Manchester, Oldham Road. Monday Street, 11 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 9 October 1917 aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
