Personal History

Roland FOSTER was born at Horwich (Rivington), Lancashire in 1893 the son of Thomas and Ann FOSTER nee JONES who were married 1891 at The Chapelry, Rivington.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 5, Short Street, Horwich,. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Labourer in Paperworks.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 11, Heavily Road, Horwich.. He was aged 7

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Labourer

Service History

He was living at Horwich when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Bolton, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 15 June 1915. His last known address was Boltn, Brownlow Fold, Southern Street, 23 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 27 August 1915 in Gallipolli aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
