Personal History

Arthur FOXALL was born at Rhodes, Middleton, Lancashire in 1891 the son of Joseph and Martha FOXALL nee UNTHANK who were married 1875 at St. Simon, Salford, Lancashire. His father died in 1928. His mother died in 1928.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 44, Cross Stree, Rhodes, Middleton, Lancashire,. He was aged 19 with the occupation of Apprentice Tinsmith.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 44, Cross Stree, Rhodes, Middleton, Lancashire,. He was aged 9 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Newton Heath as a Tinsmith

Service History

He was living at Rhodes, Middleton, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Middleton, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 5 May 1915. His last known address was Middleton, Rhodes, Cross Street, 44 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 10 November 1915 in Gallipoli aged 24

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
