Personal History

William Arthur FRYER was born at St. Helens, Lancashire in 1896 the son of Joseph A. and Sarah FRYER nee BROADY who were married 1882 at St. Paul, Warrington, Cheshire. His father died in 1943. His mother died in 1943.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Austin Cott. He was aged with the occupation of Rainford Village, Lancashire, Age 15. Train Booker.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Ormskirk Road, Rainford Vill. He was aged with the occupation of Lancashire.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Tel. and Joint Clerk

He enlisted in the Kings Liverpool Regiment at Rainford, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 31 July 1917 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
