Personal History

Walter Daniel FULLER was born at Thelnetham, Suffolk in 1891 the son of Walter George and Laura Elizabeth FULLER nee WEBSTER. His father died in 1942. His mother died in 1942.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 69, Exeter Street, Otley Road, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 19 with the occupation of Railway Worker.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 105, George Street, Bradford, Yoekshire,. He was aged 10 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Bradford as a Wagon Greaser

Service History

He enlisted in the West Yorkshire Regiment at Bradford, Yorkshire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 25 April 1918 aged 28 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
