Personal History

Thomas GARRITY was born at Horwich, Lancashire on 27 April 1887 the son of Austin and Catherine GARRITY nee QUINN who were married 1876 at Stockport Civil Marriage Registrar Attended. His father died in 1902. His mother died in 1902.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 29, Beatrice Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 24 with the occupation of Fitter at Locomotive Works.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 21, Beatrice Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 15

In the 1891 census the family were living at 31, Beatrice Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 5 with the occupation of Scholar.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company at Horwich as a Labourer

He enlisted in the Royal Engineers.

He is recorded as Died on 17 March 1919 in 54th General Hospital, France aged 31

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
