Personal History

Peter Thomas GARVIE was born at Zyrardow, Russian Poland on 13 September 1891 the son of Thomas Henry and Elizabeth GARVIE nee DICKSON who were married 12/08/1884 at . His father died in 1956. His mother died in 1956.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Kathleen GARVIE (nee MARRIOTT) They married at St. Mary's, Church, Cheadle, Cheshire on 2 December 1916

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Engineering Assistant

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Garrison Artillery. and embarked for Egypt on 3 April 1915. His last known address was Cheadle, The Grange

He is recorded as Killed in action on 25 June 1917 aged 25

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
