He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 7 April 1915. His last known address was Manchester, Beswick, Beaumont Street, 63 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 15 July 1916 aged 28

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
