***Personal History***

*John Henry GENNOE was born at Salford, Lancashire in 1882 the son of Joseph and Margaret GENNOE nee SHERRY. His father died on .*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 8, Spring Vale Road, Pendleton, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 30 with the occupation of Railway Carter.*

*In the 1891 census the family were living at 50, Ordsall Lane (Horse & Jockey),. He was aged 8 with the occupation of Scholar.*

*He was a married man. His wife's name was Maria GENNOE (nee SHARPE) They married at St. Thomas, Pendleton, Salford on 3 April 1907. They had children: Frank b. 1909, Hilda b. 1911, Maria b. 1912, Elsie May b. 1914*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Office at Salford as a Carter*

***Service History***

*He was living at Pendleton, Salford when he enlisted in the South Lancashire Regiment at Salford, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 23 February 1915. His last known address was Salford, Walton Street, 38 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 13 June 1915 in No. 9 Field Amb Dressing Stn aged 33*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
