Personal History

William GIBBONS was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1898 the son of Thomas and Annie GIBBONS. His father died in 1955. His mother died in 1955.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 34, George Street, Old Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 23 with the occupation of Dock Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 70, Cooper Street, Goole,. He was aged 13
In the 1891 census the family were living at 76, Cooper Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 3
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Goole Steam Shipping at Goole as a Labourer

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry at Goole, Yorkshire. He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 1 December 1917 in 3rd General Hospital, Le Treport aged 29 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
