Personal History

Henry GIBSON was born at Bolton, Lancashire in 1891 the son of John Richard and Maria Ann GIBSON nee RILEY who were married 1889 at St. George's, Bolton, Lancashire. His father died in 1933. His mother died in 1933.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 31, Prosperous Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Cop Packer, Cotton Mill.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 50, Mount Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 11

In the 1891 census the family were living at 43, Cooper Street, Little Bolton, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 1 month

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Lostock Hall as a Fitters Labourer

Service History

He was living at Bolton, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Preston, Lancashire. on 15 February 1917

He is recorded as Killed in action on 21 September 1917 aged 26

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
