Personal History

Harry GLEDHILL was born at Leeds, Yorkshire in 1894 the son of Alfred and Elizabeth GLEDHILL nee HODGSON who were married 17/10/1885 at St. Augustine, Wrangthorpe, Leeds, Yorkshire. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 19, Bath View, Bramley, Leeds, Yorkshire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Cotton Mill Mule Piecer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 19, St. Thomas Street, Brampton, Leeds, Yorkshire,. He was aged 6 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Bradford as a Washer

He enlisted in the Prince of Wales Own Yorkshire Regiment at Leeds, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 29 May 1918 aged 23
