Personal History

William GLOVER was born at Salford, Lancashire in 1889 the son of John and Mary Ellen GLOVER nee WALLWORK who were married 01/01/1875 at All Saints, Hindley.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 49. Holland Street, Whit Lane, Pendleton, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 24 with the occupation of Wagoner (Below Grd).

In the 1891 census the family were living at 35. Withycombe, Pendleton, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 4 He was a married man. His wife's name was Elizabeth Ann GLOVER (nee MOSS) They married at St. George, Charlestown, Salford, Lancashire on 3 March 1907. They had children: Alfred b. 1909, May b. 1910, William b. 1914

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Civil Engineers Dept. at Salford as a Platelayer

Service History

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Salford, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 23 November 1915. His last known address was Salford, Pendleton, Whit Lane, Holland Street, 49 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action aged 27

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
