He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Chorley, Lancashire. on 19 November 1914 and embarked for France on 27 July 1915. His last known address was Chorley, Gaskell Street, 17 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 23 July 1916 aged 24

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
