William GOGGIN was born at Bradford, Yorkshire in 1888 the son of Arthur and Mary GOGGIN. In the 1891 census the family were living at 3, Acorn Street, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 3 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the West Riding Regiment at Bradford, Yorkshire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 20 September 1914. His last known address was Bradford, Wakefield Road, Watercock Street, 4 (CWGC). He is recorded as Killed in action on 10 October 1917 aged 30 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star
