***Personal History***

*Geoffrey Fulthorpe GOOCH was born at Cardiff, Wales on 27 July 1892 the son of Charles and Emma Susan GOOCH nee ASTWOOD who were married 1876 at . His father died on .*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at Kingsmead, Brenchley, Matfield, Kent,. He was aged 8*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Pupil*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Royal Field (Garrison) Artillery. and embarked for France on 31 July 1918. His last known address was London West, Gloucester Place, Bickenhall Mansions, 7b (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 19 September 1918 aged 26*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
