Personal History

Joseph GOODWIN was born at Shrewsbury, Shropshire in 1880 the son of Joseph Thomas and Elizabeth GOODWIN nee Warburton who were married 12/02/1877 at All Saints Church, Hockley, Warwickshire. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 12, Church Road, Bootle, Liverpool, Lancashire, aa. He was aged 31 with the occupation of Engine Fitter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 34, Caradore Road, Seaforth, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 21 with the occupation of Labourer in Match Factory.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 30, Arthur Street, Litherland, Seaforth, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 11 with the occupation of Scholar.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Blackpool as an Extra Porter

He was living at Seaforth, Liverpool when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at the same place.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 12 October 1916 aged 36

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
