Charles Francis GRAHAM was born at Swinton, Lancashire in 1896 the son of Edward and Catherine GRAHAM nee JONES who were married 1894 at Barton-on-Irwell Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died in 1927. His mother died in 1927.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 98, Swinton Hall Road, Swinton, Lancashire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Railway Telegraph Messenger.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 9, Paradise Street, Eccles, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 4

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

He enlisted in the Royal Engineers at Manchester, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 9 June 1918 in No. 30 General Hosptal France aged 21 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
