Personal History

Harold GRANGE was born at Miles Platting, Manchester in 1891 the son of John Henry and Nelie GRANGE nee AYKROYD. His father died in 1900. His mother died in 1900.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 63, Stapleton Street, Irlam O'th' Heights, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Railway Wagon Maker.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 32, Fleetwood Street, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 10

In the 1891 census the family were living at 33, Lodge Street, Harpurhey, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 11 months

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company at Salford as a Wheelwright

Service History

He was living at Irlam O' th' Heights, Salford when he enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 18 November 1915. His last known address was Salford, Irlam O' th' Heights, Stapleton Street, 63 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 4 February 1916 aged 25

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
