Personal History

David GREENWOOD was born at Halifax, Yorkshire in 1884 the son of Tom and Louisa Emma GREENWOOD nee SMITH who were married 15/06/1878 at St. John the Baptist, Halifax, Yorkshire. His father died in 1935. His mother died in 1935.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 307, Gilbert Street, Halifax, Yorkshire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Cotton Card Maker.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 21, Winding Road, Halifax,. He was aged 7 with the occupation of Scholar.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Sowerby Bridge as a Washer

Service History

He was living at Halifax, Yorkshire when he enlisted in the West Riding Regiment at the same place. on 18 November 1914

He is recorded as Killed in action on 3 May 1917 aged 33

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
