Personal History

Edwin GREENWOOD was born at Gorton, Manchester in 1898 the son of George Albert and Emily Ann GREENWOOD nee DALE who were married 25/10/1896 at Albert Memorial Church, Collyhurst, Manchester. His father died in 1974. His mother died in 1974.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 22, Carnavron Street, Hollinwood, Oldham, Lancashire,. He was aged 12 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 14, Culvert Street, Harpurhey, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 2

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company

He enlisted in the Royal Naval Reserve.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 6 May 1918 aged 20
