Personal History

William Albert GREENWOOD was born at Todmorden, Yorkshire on 28 October 1895 the son of Eli and Mary GREENWOOD nee FILDEN who were married 10/11/1883 at St. John the Baptist. Halifax, Yorkshire. His mother died in 1958.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 16, Summerfield Road, Todmorden, Yorkshire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Weaver.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 16, Summerfield Road, Todmorden, Yorkshire,. He was aged 5 with the occupation of Cholar.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Rochdale as an Extra Carter

Service History

He was living at Todmorden, Yorkshire when he enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at the same place. and embarked for Balkans on 5 May 1915. His last known address was Todmorden, River Street, 8 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 20 August 1915 aged 19

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
