Personal History

Robert BAGSHAW was born at Manchester, Lancashire in 1897 the son of John Frederick and Agnes BAGSHAW nee ALLEN who were married 29/03/1890 at St. Luke Miles Platting, Manchester.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 12, Garrett Street, Newton, Miles Platting, Manchester,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 11, Brunswick Place, Manchester,. He was aged 3
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at (Victoria) Manchester as an Overhead Traverse Driver

Service History

He enlisted in the King's (Liverpool) Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 26 September 1915. His last known address was Manchester, Lower Crumpsall, Mount Pleasant, 12 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 14 July 1916 aged 19

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
