Personal History

Neill GREGORY was born at Madeley, Staffordshire in 1893 the son of William and Sarah GREGORY.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 11, Ollertson Terrace, Presall with Hackinsall, Poulton-le-Fylde,. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Salt Rock Miner.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Parron View, Presall with Hackinsall, Poulton-le-Fylde,. He was aged 8

He was a married man. His wife's name was Elizabeth Gregory GREGORY (maiden name not known)

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Civil Engineers Dept. at Wyre Dock as a Platelayer

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Royal Lancaster Regiment at Fleetwood, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 14 February 1915. His last known address was Prestall with Hackensall, Oulton (le-Fylde, Ollertson Terrace, 11 - !911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 1 August 1916

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
