***Personal History***

*Nicholas GREGORY was born at Workington, Cumberland in 1890 the son of Peter and Mary GREGORY nee O'HARE.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 11, Pinfold Street, Workington,. He was aged 11*

*In the 1891 census the family were living at 5, Banks Lane, Workington, Cumberland,. He was aged 1*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Blackburn as a Shunter*

***Service History***

*He was living at Blackburn, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Border Regiment at Workington, Cumberland. and embarked for France on 4 January 1915. His last known address was Blackburn, Mannor Sutton Street, 4 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 6 August 1915 in Calais aged 25*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
