Personal History

Edward GREGSON was born at Bolton. Lancashire in 1891 the son of James and Honor GREGSON nee OPENSHAW who were married 12/04/1884 at All Saints, Bolton, Lancashire. His mother died in 1929.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 33, Horrock Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Cotton Mill Piecer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 29, Horrock Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 10

*In the 1891 census the family were living at 51, Lena Street, Little Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 8 months
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Scalesman*

Service History

He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Bolton, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 31 July 1915. His last known address was Bolton, Ivy Road, Horrocks, 33 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 8 June 1917 in France aged 26

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
