***Personal History***

*Alfred GRIME was born at Horwich, Lancashire in 1894 the son of Frederic and Elizabeth Ann GRIME nee TAYLOR who were married 1883 at St. Margaret, Whalley Range, Manchester, Lancashire.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 110, Chorley New Road, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 4, Hope Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 6*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Clerk*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Royal Engineers at Manchester, Lancashire.*

*He is recorded as Died on 28 October 1918 in No.1 South African Gen Hosp, France aged 24*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
