Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at
Horwich as a Clerk

He enlisted in the Royal Enginneers at Manchester, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died on 28 October 1918 in No.1 South African Gen Hosp, France aged 24 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
