Personal History

Herbert GRIME was born at Atherton, Lancashire on 8 December 1895 the son of Richard and Annie GRIME nee BARNES who were married 31/07/1895 at St. John the Baptist, Atherton, Lancashire. His father died in 1943. His mother died in 1943.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 75, Elizabeth Street, Atherton, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Collery Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 8, Col;lard Street, Atherton, Lancashire,. He was aged 5

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Civil Engineers Dept. at Atherton as a Platelayer

Service History

He was living at Westhoughton, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Own Royal Lancaster Regiment at Atherton, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 27 September 1915. His last known address was Bolton, Chequerbent, Sunny Brow Cottage (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 9 April 1917 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
