Personal History

Ernest BAILEY was born at Stocksbridge, Yorkshire on 1885? the son of Mary Ann BAILEY.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 76, Abraham Street, Blackburn, Lancashire,. He was aged 26. Earthenware Enameller

In the 1901 census the family were living at 73, Haslingden Road, Blackburn, Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Sanitary Ware Labourer.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Elizabeth BAILEY (maiden name not known)

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Blackburn as a Porter and Reserve Shunter

Service History

He was living at Blackburn, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Rifle Brigade at the same place. and embarked for France on 18 December 1915. His last known address was Blackburn, Infirmary Street, 118 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 14 November 1916

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
