Personal History

George GULSHAN was born at Bolton, Lancashire in 1894 the son of Owen and Ellen GULSHAN nee JONES who were married 1889 at Bolton Register Office or Registrar Attended . His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 94, Orlando Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Office Boy, Railway Goods Depot.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 31, George Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 7

He was a married man. His wife's name was Mary H. GULSHAN (nee MCDONALD) They married at Bolton, Registry Office or Registrar Attended, on 29 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Bolton as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Bolton, Lancashire. on 9 September 1914 and embarked for France on 24 September 1915. His last known address was Bolton, Orlando Street, 94 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 7 July 1916 aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
