Personal History

Joseph GULSHAN was born at Bolton, Lancashire in 1886 the son of Owen and Ellen GULSHAN nee JONES who were married 1889 at Bolton Register Office or Registrar Attended .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 94, Orlando Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 25 with the occupation of Rellief Railway Porter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 31, George Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Indoor Messenger, G.P.O..

In the 1891 census the family were living at 37, Rose Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 5 with the occupation of Scholar.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Excessman

He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Bolton, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 21 October 1916 aged 30
