*1045 1st/5th Battalion Lancashire Fusiliers*

*Killed in action 7 August 1915 aged 21*

*Commemorated Helles Memorial, Turkey Panels 59 to 73 & 218, 219*

***Personal History***

*James GUTHERIE was born at Workington, Cumberland in 1894.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 34, Hurst Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Railway Engine Cleaner.*

*He was a married man. His wife's name was Mary Jame GUTHERIE (nee BYRNE)*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Bury as a Cleaner*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Bury, Lancashire. and embarked for Egypt on 25 September 1914. His last known address was Bury, Hurst Street, 34 (1911 Census).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 7 August 1915 aged 21*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
