Personal History

Francis Edward HAIGH was born at Crofton, Yorkshire in 1895 the son of Foster parents of Charles and Frances HaighHAIGH.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Deot. at Huddersfield as a Clerk

Service History

He was living at Wakefield, Yorkshire when he enlisted in the Dragoon Guards at Huddersfield, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 18 May 1915. His last known address was Wakefield, Primrose Hill, South Street. 78 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 1 June 1915 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
