Personal History

William HAIGH was born at Bradford, Yorkshire in 1890 the son of Robert and Emma HAIGH nee PARRATT who were married 24/06/1872 at St. Peter (Bradford Catholic), Yorkshire. His father died in 1917. His mother died in 1917.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 33, Morpeth Street, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 21 with the occupation of Dyers Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 4, Amberley Street, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 10 In the 1891 census the family were living at 46, Robert Street, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 1 He was a married man. His wife's name was Ada Mary HAIGH (nee BAIRSTOW) They married at St. Peter, Bradford on 4 September 1912

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Meltham as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the West Riding Regiment at Bradford, Yorkshire. and embarked for Balkans on 7 July 1915. His last known address was Bradford, Leeds Road, Maudsley Street, 67 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds in Hospital Ship 'Louden' aged 25

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
