*Died of Wounds aged 25*

***Personal History***

*William HAIGH was born at Bradford, Yorkshire in 1890 the son of Robert and Emma HAIGH nee PARRATT who were married 24/06/1872 at St. Peter (Bradford Catholic), Yorkshire. His father died in 1917. His mother died in 1917.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 33, Morpeth Street, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 21 with the occupation of Dyers Labourer.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 4, Amberley Street, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 10*

*In the 1891 census the family were living at 46, Robert Street, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 1*

*He was a married man. His wife's name was Ada Mary HAIGH (nee BAIRSTOW) They married at St. Peter, Bradford on 4 September 1912*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Meltham as a Porter*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the West Riding Regiment at Bradford, Yorkshire. and embarked for Balkans on 7 July 1915. His last known address was Bradford, Leeds Road, Maudsley Street, 67 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds in Hospital Ship 'Louden' aged 25*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
