Personal History

Ernest (Edward) Frederick HALFORD was born at Hammersmith on 3 November 1887 the son of Edward and Letitia Thomasina HALFORD nee HOSE who were married 02/02/1889 at St. Mary, Ealing. His father died in 1934. His mother died in 1934.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as an Inspector

He enlisted in the Royal Engineers. and embarked for France on 14 December 1916. His last known address was London, Putney, Putney Hill, 27 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died on 10 October 1918 in Wellesley House Officers Hospital aged 30

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
