Personal History

Alfred HALL was born at Salford, Lancashire in 1897 the son of George Edward and Sarah Ann HALL nee ABRAHAM who were married 27/12/1875 at St. Phillip, Salford, Lancashire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 40, Queen Street, Newton Heath, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Bolt Polishing at Elect. Engineers.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 75, Cran. He was aged Street with the occupation of Manchester, Lancashire, Age 5.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Newton Heath as a Cleaner

Service History

He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 10 November 1915. His last known address was Newton Heath, Droylsden Road, Queen Street. 40 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 1 July 1916 aged 19

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
