Personal History

John HALL was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1894 the son of John and Mary HALL nee WARWICK who were married 1888 at Hunslet District Registered Building, Leeds. His mother died in 1900.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 67, Marlboro Avenue, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Railway Engine Cleaner.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 49, Marlbro Avenue, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 7
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at
Goole as a Cleaner

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry at Goole, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 11 September 1915. His last known address was Goole, Marlbro Avenue, 67 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 1 July 1916 aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
