In the 1911 census the family were living at 50, Laneshead, Healey, Rochdale, Lancashire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 73, Kings Bridge, Rochdale, Lancashire,. He was aged 4 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Joint Clerk
