Personal History

Harold HARDY was born at Bolton, Lancashire in 1896 the son of Enoch and Elizabeth Ann HARDY nee HOLDEN who were married 14/06/1894 at St. Michael, Great Lever, Bolton, Lancashire. His father died in 1930. His mother died in 1930.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 150, Parkfield Road, Great Lever, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 Cotton Mule Piecer

In the 1901 census the family were living at 204, Deane Road, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 5
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at
Bolton as a Fireman

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery at Bolton, Lancashire. and embarked for Egypt on 16 June 1915. His last known address was Bolton, Tonge Moor Road, 317 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 27 March 1918 aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
