***Personal History***

*Harold HARDY was born at Bolton, Lancashire in 1896 the son of Enoch and Elizabeth Ann HARDY nee HOLDEN who were married 14/06/1894 at St. Michael, Great Lever, Bolton, Lancashire. His father died in 1930. His mother died in 1930.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 150, Parkfield Road, Great Lever, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 Cotton Mule Piecer*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 204, Deane Road, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 5*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Bolton as a Fireman*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery at Bolton, Lancashire. and embarked for Egypt on 16 June 1915. His last known address was Bolton, Tonge Moor Road, 317 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 27 March 1918 aged 22*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
