Personal History

Robert HARGREAVES was born at Blackrod, Lancashire in 1889 the son of MariaHARGREAVES. His mother died in 1910.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 2, Marshes Square, Blackrod, Lancashire,. He was aged 22 with the occupation of Labourer at Locomotive Works.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 8, Black Horse Street, Blackrod, Lancashire,. He was aged 12 with the occupation of Dodger at Bleachworks.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 19, Hill Lane Blackrod, Lancashire,. He was aged 2 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Labourer

Service History

He was living at Blackrod, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Horwich, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 4 May 1915. His last known address was Blackrod, Marshes Square. 2 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 12 October 1916 in France aged 27 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
