Personal History

Robert Kemp HARGREAVES was born at Beaumaris, Wales in 1895 the son of John Charles and Jane HARGREAVES nee PARRY who were married 1880 at Bangor, Anglesey, Wales. His father died in 1938. His mother died in 1938.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 6, Guladys Street, Walton-on-the-Hill, -. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Sandhills as a Cleaner

Service History

He was living at Kirkdale, Liverpool when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Liverpool, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 19 May 1915. His last known address was Liverpool, Kirkdale, Westminster Road, 314

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 14 December 1915 in No.10 Casualty Clearing Stn France aged 20 He was awarded the Victory Medal and British War Medal
