Personal History

Peter HARPER was born at Kirkdale, Liverpool, Lancashire on 18 January 1895 the son of Andrew and Elizabeth HARPER nee MCMILLAN who were married 1889 at St. Peter, Liverpool, Lancashire. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 1, Sylvia Street, Kirkdale, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 16 In the 1901 census the family were living at 41, Marsh Street, Kirkdale, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 6 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Bootle as a Porter

Service History

He was living at Bootle, Liverpool, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Liverpool, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 26 September 1915. His last known address was Liverpool, Berry Street, 112 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 12 July 1916 aged 21 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
