Killed in action 15 June 1915 aged 20

Personal History

HARRISON was born at Horwich, Lancashire in 1894 the son of George William and Emily HARRISON nee ROYLE who were married 1889 at Christ Church, Patricroft. His father died in 1946. His mother died in 1946.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 112, Lee Lane, Horwich, Bolton,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Apprentice At Locomotive Railway Works.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 43, Catherine Street West, Horwich, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 6

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as an Apprentice

Service History

He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Horwich, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 4 May 1915. His last known address was Horwich, Bolton, Lee Lane, 112 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 15 June 1915 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
