*George Haigh HARRISON was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1896 the son of Grand F. George and Grand M. Hannah HARRISON. His father died on .*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 10. Parliament Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Apprentice House Painter.*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept as a Porter*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry at Leeds, Yorkshire.*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 14 April 1916 in No.1 Casualty Clearing Station aged 19*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
