George Haigh HARRISON was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1896 the son of Grand F. George and Grand M. Hannah HARRISON. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 10. Parliament Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Apprentice House Painter.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept as a Porter

He enlisted in the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry at Leeds, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 14 April 1916 in No.1 CasualtyClearing Station aged 19

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
